

SONY TUNER TGV-100 US or JAPANESE

While walking in the park, record TV off the air or keep an eye on your camera operator.

For the Clamshells: GVA-500, GVA-700, GVF-700 and GVD-800, GVD-900, GVD-1000 as well as DVCAM models etc.

These new Japanese model tuners are just like the discontinued NTSC TGV-100s made for USA. The lowest USA channel they tune to is 9, the highest channel is USA 62. This tuner will not receive VHF Channels 2-8. The Japanese count channels differently. In the VHF range 9-13 if you want to watch channel 9, you dial in 7 on the display. In the UHF range 14-62 if you want to watch channel 59, you dial in 58 on the display.

It's like this:

USA CHANNEL	15	16	17	...60	61	62
Displayed number	14	15	16	...59	60	61

These are guaranteed to work. We checked all for proper functioning; they receive as well as the USA models or better but not below USA channel 9. Clamshell not included. All chassis markings are in Japanese. We include an English instruction sheet.

Tech tip: The best way to find the channel being broadcast is to use the "scanning channels" feature. This adjusts the receive frequency precisely to the transmitted channel.
